Wire-spoke hubcap stolen

A wire-spoke hubcap, valued at \$125 was stolen from a vehicle owned by Dorus Klinkman, 3685 N. Cemetery Rd., Cass City, during the evening hours of June 25.

According to the report, filed by Cass City Police Officer Donald Miller Jr., the hubcap was stolen from the vehicle while it was parked in Klinkman's driveway.

sentenced a 26-year-old Marlette man to 24 to 48 months in Southeastern Michigan Prison, after a jury found him guilty of felonious assault and malicious destruction charges.

Judge Joslyn also recommended that Jeffrey I. Wendorf, 26, 657 Germania Rd., Marlette, receive psychiatric and rehabilitation counseling and rehabilitation training while in prison.

The charge stems from an attack on Elaine Martin, 1695 Ryan Rd., Caro, June 28, 1984. According to the report, Martin was driving from Cass City to the Caro area at 11:00 p.m. after working the afternoon shift at Provincial House.

After Martin turned off M-24 onto Riley Road, Wendorf passed her, stopped in the middle of the road and backed his truck into the Martin vehicle seven or eight times. While trying to flee, Martin lost control of the vehicle and Wendorf kicked the driver's side window out. Martin was able to escape and Wendorf was later arrested.

A Tuscola County Circuit Court jury found Wendorf guilty of felonious assault and malicious destruction of personal property over \$100 following a two-day trial that ended May 10.

Wendorf was given credit for 54 days already served in the Tuscola County jail. In other July 1 court action, Judge Joslyn sentenced Clayton J. Fox, 43, Caro, to 347 days in the Tuscola County jail on a charge of malicious destruction to a building over \$100. Fox was given credit for 347 days already served.

# Paris visitor experiences life on Huron County farm

For one month this summer, Sandrine Lhootel has traded the sights and sounds of her home near Paris, for the rural life of Huron County.

Miss Lhootel, 17, came to the area on a cultural exchange program sponsored by NACEL Cultural Exchange, a program designed to give students a first-hand look at the lifestyle of people in other countries. She is staying with the Don and Sharon Cummins family, 5490 MacAlpine Rd., Gagetown, during her visit to the United States. Miss Lhootel paid for the entire cost of her trip. The Cummins provide room and board during her stay.

Miss Lhootel, who speaks limited English, pointed to the television set when explaining that her father, Daniel, works in the broadcasting industry. During her stay, Janice Cummins, a junior at Owen-Gage, will serve as her interpreter. Janice has had one year of French at the Owen-Gage High School. Mrs. Cummins, who also had one year of French while in high school, explained the exchange program matches host families with the student's background to make the one-month stay an easier adjustment for the youth.

Miss Lhootel, a junior, plans on going to college for secretarial training after graduating from high school. She said that in France most students continue their education after high school. College tuition is free in France. In high school she learned to speak English and Spanish along with other classes such as mathematics, biology, physics and drafting. Like America, in most French households, both parents work. Miss

Lhootel's mother, Elaine, works as a secretary. Her family owns a house in her home city of Port Marly, and a second, summer home in the country. Miss Lhootel explained that her house in Port Marly is similar to a stan-

dard three-bedroom American home. They spend their vacations in their country house.

Miss Lhootel comes from a large family by French standards. She has one brother and two sisters.

Like most American families, the Lhootels own two cars.

Don Cummins said he is planning on taking a vacation this month, and will take Lhootel and his family to the Cedar Point Amusement Park.

## Seek Chicago-Detroit rail line

Legislation authorizing the development of a high speed rail line between Detroit and Chicago is being prepared by Representative Raymond Murphy (D-Detroit).

He said that in light of federal budget cuts, the state must take the lead in developing a high speed rail system, which could boost tourism and spur small business development.

The proposed legislation would create a state authority to manage and operate the rail line, establish an advisory council for high speed rail, create a tri-state high speed rail commission in Michigan, Indiana, and Illinois, set standards for awarding a rail franchise, and provide for the issuance of notes and bonds to build the project.
