

County Board okays building permit fee hikes during meet

Persons who plan to build in Tuscola County will have to dig a little deeper in their pockets to pay for some building permit fees following action by the County Board of Commissioners last week.

Commissioners, on a recommendation from Department of Public Works Director Paul Lefler, approved a new permit fee schedule with average increases of 15 to 20 percent.

Most of the fees that were increased are related to plumbing and electrical work, according to Lefler, who stated that some permits related to mechanical work, particularly for commercial projects, will cost more.

"What we're doing is trying to recover a reasonable amount of the cost," Lefler said after the meeting. He explained that while many basic permits in the county were up to date and were not increased, others, such as those for plumbing, electrical and miscellaneous work, and some inspections were in line for increases.

Under the new fee structure, fees for work such as adding a garage to an existing building, modular and mobile homes, pole buildings and building moving were increased between \$10 and \$20.

Permits for double-wide

homes with crawl spaces now will cost \$70, up by \$20, while double-wides with basements now cost \$95, also up by \$20. Lefler said that the minimum electrical permit increased from \$25 to \$35.

"For a new average residence (1,200 square feet), there would be an \$18 increase overall" for permits, Lefler remarked.

Also changed are the fees for inspections. While special visits will now cost \$10 more at \$35 and final inspections are now \$15, up by \$5, return inspections conducted while on route were reduced from \$25 to \$15, according to Lefler, who said that the county's last fee increases were in 1981.

PHASING OUT

In other business during the board's Sept. 8 regular meeting, commissioners discussed a proposal which would eventually phase out the county's motor pool.

According to county Controller Michael Hoagland, the Buildings and Grounds Committee recommended that the 1988 budget include vehicle purchases for Probate Court (Juvenile), Friend of the Court, Department of Social Services and Animal Control. With the exception of the animal

control vehicle, the purchases would be subsidized by full or partial reimbursements from the state, he added.

Hoagland, who noted there's a high dependency on the motor pool's mechanic, added the majority of the pool's 13 vehicles are former patrol cars and "typically have more than 100,000 miles" on them.

Also recommended was that collision coverage on the pool cars be eliminated.

"We're just trying to evaluate if that's (motor pool) the most cost-effective method of providing transportation," he remarked.

Hoagland pointed out that the purchases are only recommendations to the Finance Committee at this time, and that some departments, including the Department of Public Works, Cooperative Extension Service and Public Health Department, would continue to use the motor pool for the present.

STAFFING

Turning to a request made last month by county Prosecutor William Bond to fill a vacancy in his office previously held by assistant prosecutor David Grunst, commissioners de-

clined to take any action on the vacancy.

Commissioners may have tabled the issue because of the absence at the meeting of Commissioner John Goodchild, who chairs the board's Personnel Committee.

Commissioners last month decided not to fill the position immediately in order to investigate the possibility of moving the Cooperative Reimbursement Program to the Friend of the Court. The program had been handled by Grunst, whose salary was partially reimbursed by the state for work on paternity cases.

Also last week, the board heard an update on the county's membership in the East Central Planning Commission. It will cost some \$300 less for the county to be a member in 1988, according to Hoagland, who said that the dues, which total about \$4,300, decreased because of the county's dropping land values.

Also, commissioners approved paying \$3,500 for a computer fund accounting software purchase, but payment (about \$3,000) for payroll software was postponed pending further review; purchase of a desk chair for \$300 was okayed; and use of the courthouse
