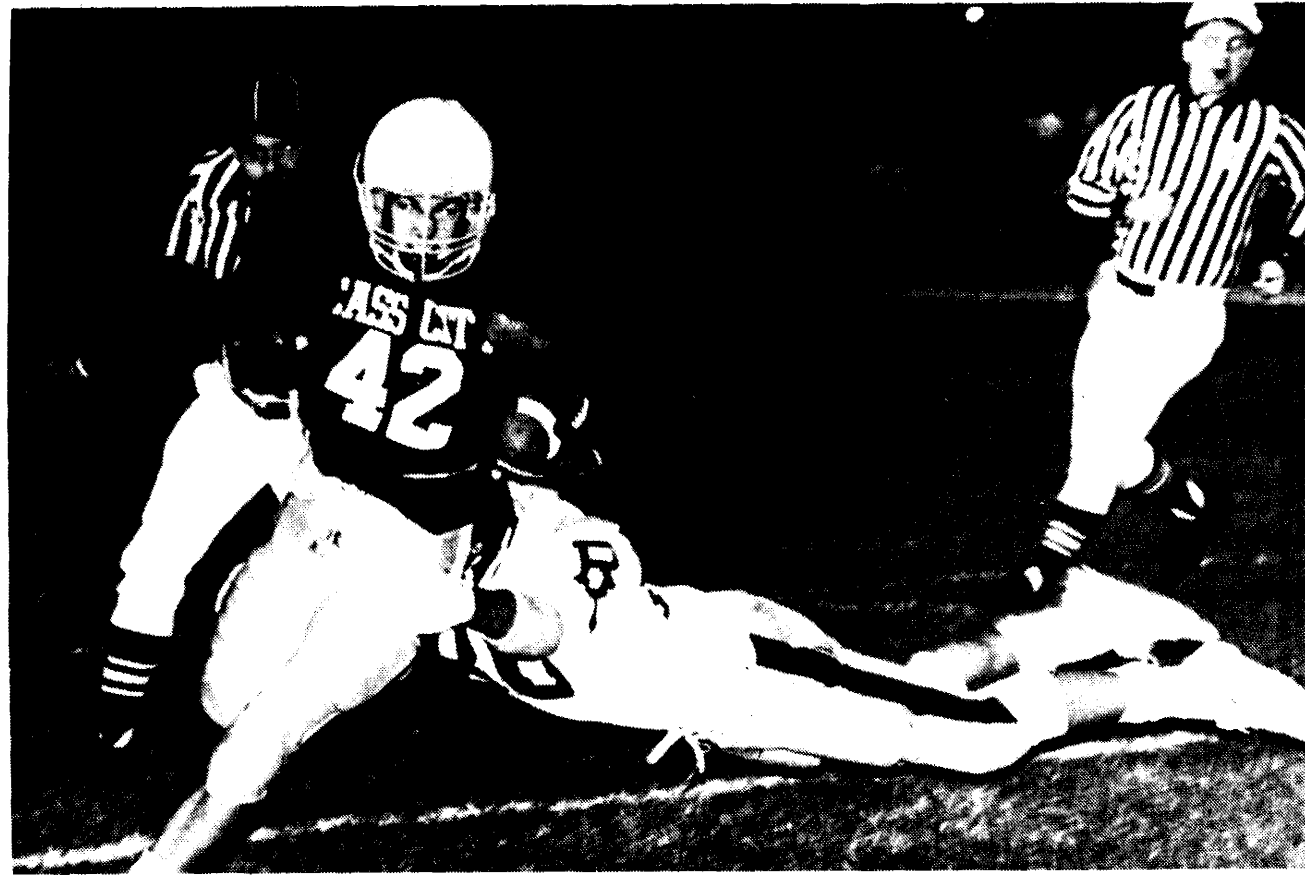

20-14 loss

DuRussell, Reese derail Cass City in final game

Sometimes the results of a football game are determined by a key play or 2. One of those games took place Friday night when the Cass City Red Hawks played the Reese Rockets at Cass City Recreation Park in the final game of the season. Reese won the game, 20-14, with a touchdown as time ran out, but the key plays in the game came in the first half.

Until there was just a little under 4 minutes left in the first half, Cass City dominated the game. In the first period, after an exchange of punts, the Hawks started a drive on their own 21-yard line. It was a precision march mixing some hard running by Tim Englehart and key passes from Brad Gray to Troy Perry. A fumble on the Reese 20 almost stopped the drive. But with fourth and 4, a long count drew a Reese lineman offside and from there the Hawks marched in. Englehart scored from the 2-yard line. Given a second chance on the extra points effort when Reese was whistled for offside, the Hawks made the most of it as Englehart ran it in.

In the second period the Hawks started another drive on their own 30-yard line and moved to the Reese 15 to set up the first key play of the game. On a pitch to the half-back he lofted a pass to a Hawk receiver all alone in the end zone. The ball, which was a little high but still catchable, was dropped. Until that time the Rockets

had not been able to generate any offense, not even a first down.

It appeared as if Cass City had the game under control until the Rockets exploded a homemade bomb named Kurt DuRussell. DuRussell dashed off tackle, broke in the clear and went 85 yards to score and the score was 8-6 and Reese still did not have a first down. It was the longest run of the year against Cass City.

After that dash the game changed and the visitors started piling up yardage, although neither team scored again until the final

period, when DuRussell broke loose again with 5:37 left to put Reese ahead for the first time. The run for the crucial extra points was good.

Cass City bounced back from that one and scored with 4:35 left as Greg Graham pounded over from the 3. The crucial extra point kick was blocked to leave the teams tied and set the stage for the winning march as time ran out.

Englehart made the final game of his high school career a good one with 141 yards in 23 carries for a 6.1 average. Many of his yards came on second efforts and

broken tackles. Matt Weippert and Graham also made their final game a good one. Weippert led the defense

with 11 tackles, including 5 solo, and Graham was credited with 12 tackles, 4 solo, scored a touchdown and caught 2 passes for 17 yards.

Legal assistance services are funded through the Region VII Area Agency on Aging under Title III B of the Older Americans Act. Services are provided to eligible persons age 60 and older on a donation basis; there is no set fee for the service.

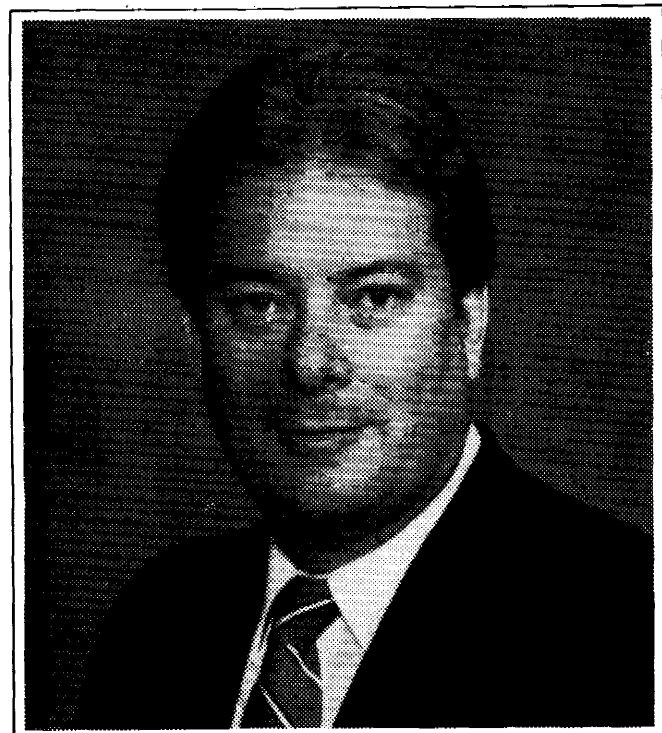

Lengthy terms handed down Friday

Ferguson, Fortson face prison

Campaign trail

Lieutenant governor candidate Connie Binsfeld stops in Cass City during Thumb media blitz

Connie Binsfeld, Republican candidate for lieutenant governor, stopped in Cass City Monday morning as part of a media blitz in the Thumb.

The 66-year-old grandmother has been a state senator from the 36th district since 1983, moving to the senate from the House of Representatives, where she

served from 1975 to 1982. Since being selected as a running mate for John Engler, she has conducted a whirlwind campaign across the state, already visiting 70 counties. She said her day starts at 6 or 7 a.m. and extends to 11 or 12 p.m. each night.

She is a pro-life advocate, believing that abortion should be allowed only if the health of the mother is threatened and for no other reason.

She and John Engler, GOP governor candidate, advocate a system of "competition in education" and would like to see a change in the constitution which

would allow payment to private schools. Binsfeld also points out that the Engler plan for education supports a revision of teacher tenure laws "making it easier for good teachers to move up and bad teachers to move out."

Before coming to Cass City, Binsfeld spoke with radio and newspaper representatives in Bad Axe and planned to meet with the media in Caro and in Millington later in the day.

Binsfeld and her husband, John, have been married for 43 years and have 5 adult children. She is an active member of the St. Rita-St. Joseph Catholic Church.

Two Tuscola County men—one convicted of rape and another on manslaughter and drug-related charges—received hefty prison terms Friday in Tuscola County Circuit Court. Allen L. Ferguson of Caro, who was charged with raping, abducting and again raping a woman early this year in Caro and Watertown Township, was sentenced to 30 years to 60 years in prison for his Aug. 28 plea of no contest to one count of first degree Criminal Sexual Conduct.

The plea was part of a plea bargain agreement in which another count of first degree Criminal Sexual Conduct and charges of kidnapping and unlawfully driving away an automobile were dropped.

Investigators said Ferguson, 27, sexually assaulted the woman at her place of employment in Caro Jan. 25, then abducted her, drove to the southern part of the county and again assaulted her in her own vehicle.

Also Friday, John D. Fortson Jr., Mayville, received 4 prison sentences, including a 10- to 15-year term for voluntary manslaughter in connection with the fatal shooting of a Cass City man.

Fortson, 31, was also ordered to serve a 2-year term for a felony firearm violation. Both convictions, handed down by a jury Sept. 21, resulted from a trial involving the murder of John A. Bulla of Cass City Jan. 6 in Mayville.

In a separate case, Fortson was sentenced to prison terms of 5 years to 20 for each of 2 drug-related convictions returned by a jury Aug. 23.

The convictions were on charges of delivery of cocaine and conspiracy to deliver cocaine Nov. 21, 1989, in Mayville, according to court records, which state Fortson also was ordered to pay a \$5,000 fine.

Also sentenced to prison Friday was a Mayville man

who failed to appear for his sentencing.

Roy C. Palmerton, 40, was ordered to serve 3 years to 5 years for his Aug. 28 conviction on a charge of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of liquor, third offense, April 28 in Akron Township.

Palmerton also was sentenced to 90 days in the county jail for transporting an open intoxicant in a motor vehicle, court records state.

Millington resident Andre J. Paquette, 25, was sentenced to one year in the county jail, with permission to take part in the work release program, for his Oct. 5 plea of guilty to possession of marijuana with intent to deliver March 28 in Millington Township.

Troy K. Martens, 23, of Vassar, was sentenced for a Sept. 7 plea of guilty to a charge of writing 3 non-sufficient fund checks within 10 days.

He was sentenced to 2 years probation and 180 days in jail (deferred without a date), and ordered to pay a \$30 per month oversight fee, \$504 in restitution, a \$100 fine and \$100 in court costs plus attorneys fees.

Court records state Martens was charged with writing non-sufficient fund checks of \$45, \$65 and \$105 Aug. 5-10 in Mayville. All the checks were drawn on the Michigan Federal Credit Union.

Cass City resident Charles A. Lane, 6350 Pine St., received a one-year delayed sentence and was ordered to pay court costs of \$400 plus attorneys fees for his Sept. 18 plea of guilty to breaking and entering with intent to commit larceny.

The charge stemmed from the Jan. 4 break-in of the C. Clark Boylan residence, 6008 E. Cass City Rd., court records state.

PLEAS ENTERED

In other proceedings Friday, a 27-year-old Otter Lake man pleaded innocent to 2 counts of assault with a dangerous weapon (knife), and one count of malicious

destruction of property under \$100.

A pre-trial for the defendant, Gerald A. Taylor, is to be scheduled. Bond was continued at \$4,000.

According to court records, the charges stem from an incident that occurred May 11 in Watertown Township and involved a 1982 Chevrolet pickup truck.

Camp Tuscola inmate James H. Wright, 21, pleaded guilty during his arraignment on a charge of prison escape.

Sentencing is to be scheduled for the defendant, whose bond was continued at \$25,000.

Records state Wright was charged with escaping from a community residential center located at 626 Allen St., Caro, July 17.

Also, Jeremy R. Gatz, 20, of Birch Run, entered a plea of guilty to attempted unlawfully driving away an automobile.

His sentencing, as well as a

pre-trial hearing, is to be scheduled. Bond was continued at \$5,000.

The charge against Gatz stems from a Sept. 30 inci-

dent in Arbel Township involving a semi-tractor and trailer belonging to K & W Trucking, court records state.
