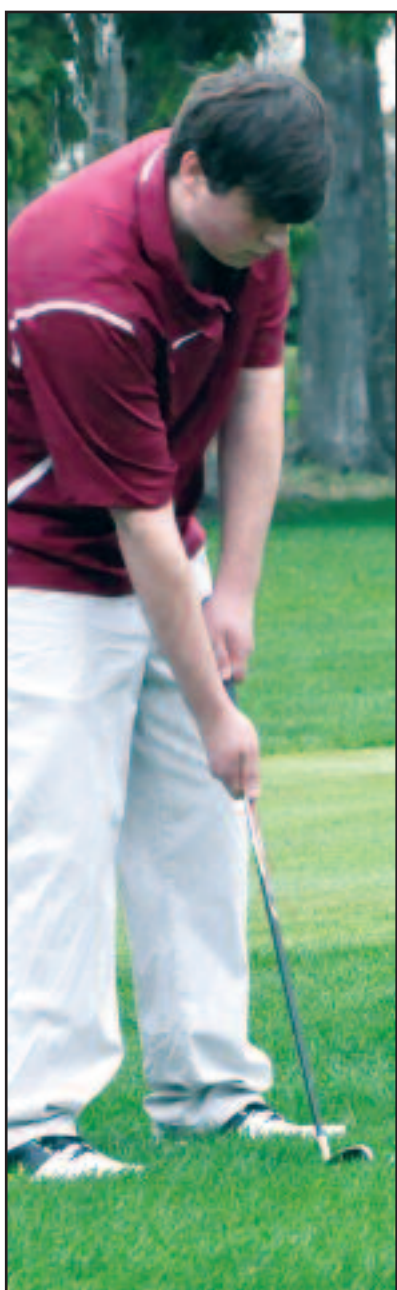

The Red Hawk senior - along with teammate Chandler Cryderman - advanced into this week's regional competition in Auburn Hills as individual qualifiers from the 12-school affair. Coach Nick Moyer wanted more.

Cass City extended its softball win streak to 8 straight Thursday with a double header sweep over visiting Harbor Beach.

## Top athletes on display at Meet of Champions

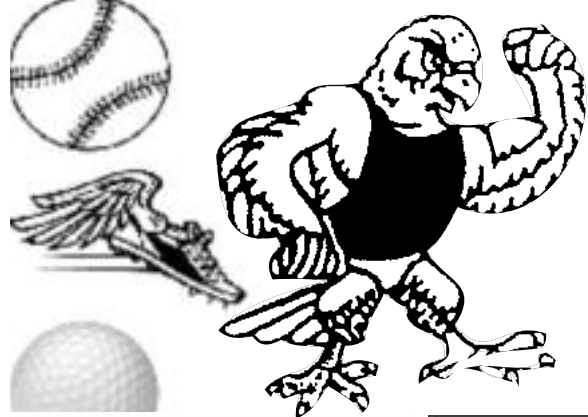

# Report: non-traditional courts in Michigan are saving lives and bettering communities

and judicial status hearings. "We're pleased to see that the work we have been putting into our program is paying off," Tuscola County Chief Judge Kim David Glaspie said in late 2013 after the Thumb's trial courts embarked on a cooperative experiment designed to give them tools outside of the traditional fines and jail time to encourage those repeatedly convicted of driving under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol to turn over a new leaf. "Investing our time and energy now to get these people off the cycle of substance abuse, criminal consequences, and further abuse leading to recidivism, makes our community happier, healthier and wealthier," Glaspie said. The new Michigan Supreme Court report provides a detailed look into the accomplishments of problem-solving courts. For example, graduates of sobriety courts are one-fourth as likely as the general population to be convicted of

any new criminal offense within two years of admission to a program. When that window is extended to four years from admission, sobriety court participants are still about half as likely as the general population to be convicted of any new criminal offense. When attention shifts to the drug- or alcohol-related offenses that sobriety courts target, the results are even more impressive. Even though sobriety court participants are, by definition, people with uniquely difficult substance abuse problems, they are less than one-third as likely as the general population to be convicted of a new drug- or alcohol-related offense within two years of admission, and about half as likely to be convicted of a new drug- or alcohol-related offense within four years of admission. "We can also measure the success of Michigan's problem-solving courts in dollars and cents," the Michigan Supreme Court justices wrote in their introduction to the "Solving Problems, Saving Lives" report.

Remick, 42, who was pronounced dead at the scene of the crash. The accident occurred at about 12:20 a.m. at the intersection of Murphy Lake and North Lake roads, according to troopers. Few details were available, but investigators said Remick had two passengers, and the other vehicle, a 2000 Mercedes Benz station wagon, had two occupants. The driver of the Mercedes Benz, Katie Arbogast, 20, of Columbiaville, and a passenger of the ATV were transported to Covenant Hospital in Saginaw by FlightCare Helicopter, according to reports, which state a third person on the ATV and the other state wagon occupant were taken to Covenant Hospital by ambulance. The Tuscola County Sheriff's Department, Mayville Fire Department, Mayville Ambulance and MMR Ambulance all assisted troopers at the scene.

### Snover man hurt

Sanilac County Sheriff's deputies reported they were dispatched to investigate a personal injury accident Monday afternoon. "The investigation determined that 20-year-old Charles Albrecht of Snover was traveling eastbound on Basler Road near North State Road in Sanilac Township when the steering went out on the four-wheeler," Sgt. Shelly Park said. "The four-wheeler went into the ditch on the south side of Basler Road and rolled over." Albrecht suffered injuries and was transported to McKenzie Memorial Hospital by Sanilac EMS and was later flown to Saginaw Covenant Hospital by FlightCare. "(Albrecht) was not wearing a helmet at the time of the accident and alcohol does not appear to be a factor," said Park, who noted deputies were assisted at the scene by the Port Sanilac Fire Department, Sanilac EMS and the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (DNR).

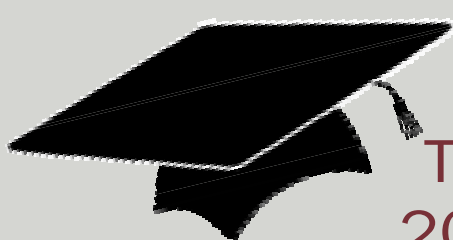

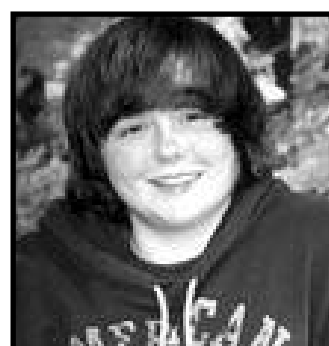

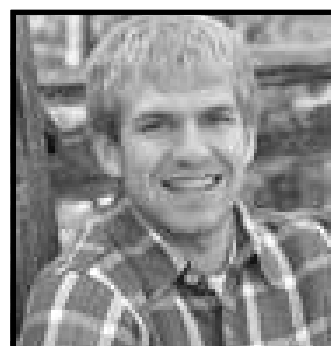
