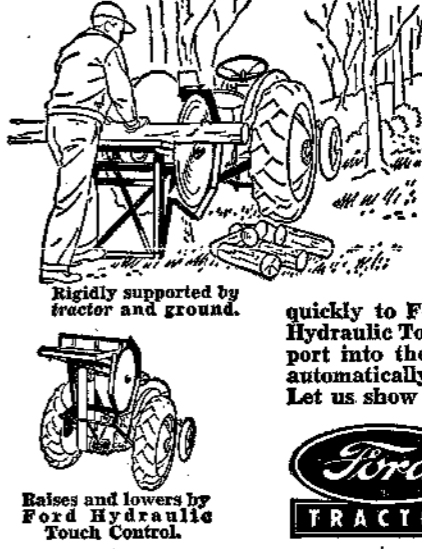
The next meeting will be held December 3, at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Nick Alexander of Gageton. A potluck lunch was served
