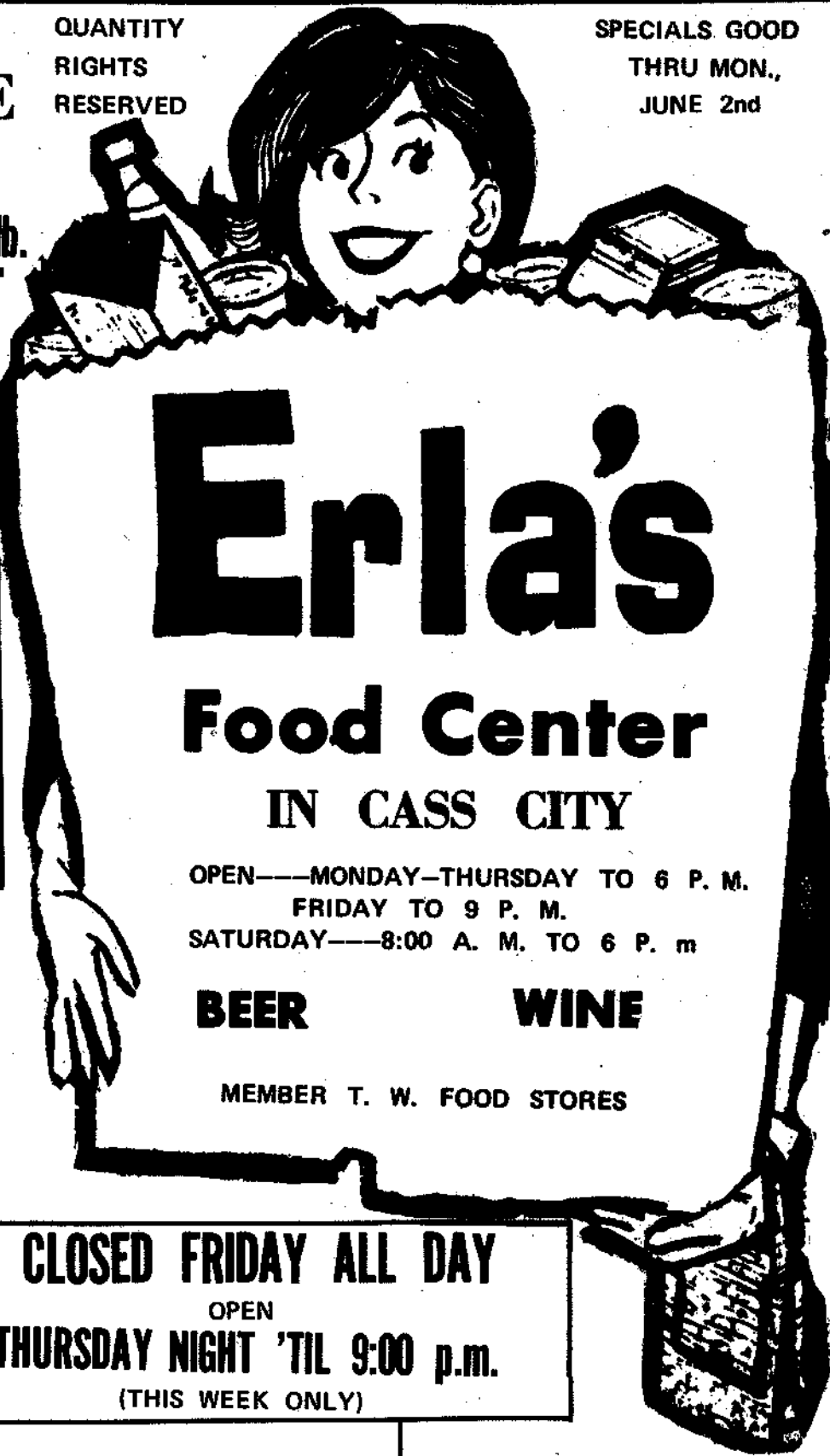

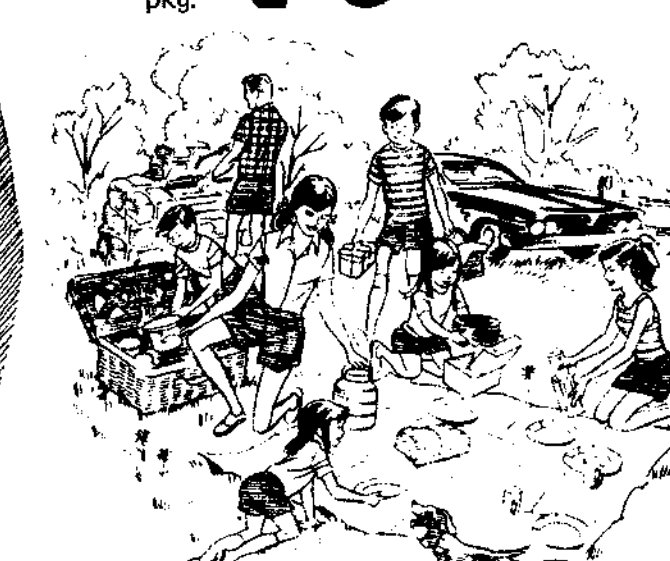

FIRING LINE
A Dalton brother
later sold real estate

The Chronicle's circulation auditor who is with Chicago's Audit Bureau of Circulations was telling us last week about the Dalton Gang whose legendary finale was brought to an end in his home town of Coffeyville, Kansas.

The auditor, John T. Tew, a careerist of about 30 with a noticeable Kansan accent did research on his hometown while in high school and also had a junior high teacher who was an authority on the notorious event in which the townspeople met gunfire to gunfire with the lawless Dalton gang.

The junior high teacher, H.H. Benfield, was six years old when on October 5, 1892, the gang came to town and attempted a double-bank robbery which ended in their own slaughter and the murder of four of the townspeople.

Benfield was in the small Kansan trading town on business and when the shooting started, Tew related, Benfield hid under a table on the second floor of a hardware store.

The gang had become legendary because of the Northfield Bank Robbery and numerous train robberies across the Oklahoma-Texas region.

In the gang of six there were three Dalton brothers, Leader Robert Dalton and Grant and Emmet Dalton.

With the sixth man outside of town waiting for them, they divided up and entered both banks. They had been in town a day or two and hadn't in the past committed any crimes in or near Coffeyville.

This was during a time in which townspeople, with poor communication to other regions, left even notorious newcomers alone until they committed a wrong.

The gunfire became fantastic as they exited the banks, except for Robert Dalton, who made for a bank's rear exit, shot square between the eyes an innocent hardware store owner on his way to the horses, only to be gunned down in return by the town sheriff who was waiting for them where their horses were at the rear of another store.

The only gang member who survived was Emmet Dalton who was lined up on the ground on main street along with his

legendary cohorts, the rest of them dead.

The gangster waiting at the edge of town escaped and lived on marauding for three more years until he met death as his bank-robbing friends had.

Emmet Dalton, 19 at the time, was sentenced to 35 years in a penitentiary. His brother Dalton received only a bent-over pipe as his gravestone marker.

The town later erected a museum and collected the guns, clothes buttons, and pieces of other attire the frenzied crowd had ripped off them as the gang lay on the dirt main street.

To commemorate the four townspeople whose lives were taken, the town named the museum the "Dalton Defenders' Museum."

But 19-year-old Emmet Dalton lived out his sentence and when he returned to Coffeyville the town was jittery that he might in some way revenge the death of his two brothers.

Instead, he only erected a gravestone marker over their graves, and then, went on to a successful real estate enterprise in California.

Our auditor says the movies now glamorize the infamous criminals of the West. "We make heroes of them," he said.

Complete color-coordinated cooking pans -- almost too pretty to put in the cupboard -- are fast replacing grandma's heavy, burnt-black iron skillet.

They come in several materials - aluminum, glass, iron and steel, with finishes as durable and easy-care as they are colorful.

One of the newest exterior finishes is Polymide, a thermosetting plastic, chemically related to nylon. It's most often applied to an aluminum base for a colorful, smooth, dishwasher-safe surface. This finish can be applied to lighter weight aluminums than those finished with porcelain enamels.


On the inside of the new pots and pans, the "second generation" non-stick finishes are adding to the cleanliness. A dip in hot soap or detergent to remove the factory finish, and pre-seasoning get these pans ready for use. From then on, cleaning involves allowing the utensil to cool, washing in hot suds with a dishcloth, cellulose sponge or sponge cloth (never steel wool, metal scouring pads or cleanser), rinsing and drying.

The teflon-treated surfaces can present a problem, however; they're so easy to clean that a hurried homemaker is often tempted to give them a "once-over-lightly" wash. Then a film of grease builds up which eventually causes sticking problems.

These stubborn food residues can be removed with a mixture of one cup of water, two tablespoons baking soda, and one-half cup liquid household bleach. 

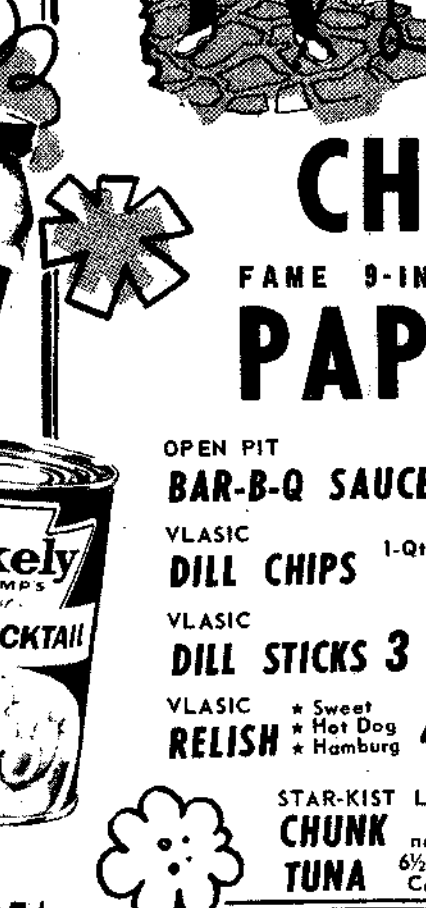

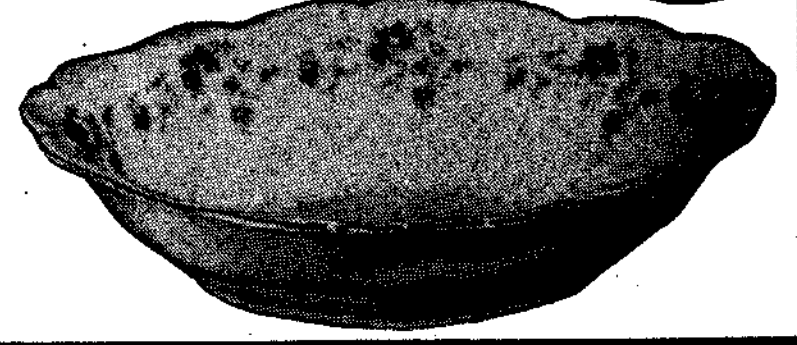
