## **Criminal complaints** total 544 last month

The Tuscola County Sheriff's Department received a total of 544 criminal complaints in January, compared to 566 the month

The greatest number, 189, involved traffic violations and accidents, followed by larcenies, 71, vandalism, 51, domestic problems, 37, and burglaries, 36.

Deputies made 57 arrests, of which 26 were for traffic violations and five each for larcenies and probation vio-

There were 327 traffic tickets issued, including 170 for speeding, 42 for defective equipment and 24 for insurance violations (no proof of insurance).

Patrol units traveled 40,586 miles in January and consumed 4,183.3 gallons of gasoline (9.7 miles per gal-

The county jail received 136 inmates, including seven females, and released 124.

Arrests made or charges brought by Cass City police during the month totaled six, of which three were for traffic violations, two for vandalism and one for lar-

Caro state police made 14 arrests, of which nine were for traffic violations. Gagetown police made one arrest for assault; Kingston police, one for a traffic offense.


