Your Neighbor says I would like to stop smoking

Mary Jane Ryba started smoking when she was a teenager. Since then, the longest the mother of three grown children has gone without taking a puff is five days.

U.S. Surgeon General Julius Richmond recently reported that the death rate of women from lung cancer, reflecting the large number of women who started smoking after World War II, is increasing rapidly and will probably surpass the death rate from breast cancer by 1983.

In the early 1960s, fewer than five women per 100,000 died from lung cancer. The rate had tripled to 15 deaths per 100,000 in 1978, which translates into approximately 25,000 deaths per year.

Mrs. Ryba is aware of the surgeon general's study. "It made me think about it (quitting smoking), but I haven't done anything about it. I wish I could find some way to make me quit."

She presently smokes less than a pack a day but at one time was a two pack a day smoker.

"Every once in a while I quit for a day and that's about it." The longest she



Mrs. Ryba has lasted without lighting up for five days and almost went out of my mind. She started smoking as a teenager because "everyone I knew smoked." She now regrets it. "I wish I never thought it was so smart to start smoking." The most noticeable disadvantage, in addition to the expense, she said, is that it smells up clothes, hair and house. Mrs. Ryba's husband John stopped smoking about 15 years ago. They live on Milligan Road. They have three children, only one of whom smokes, and one grandchild.

Proposed additions to the zoning ordinance will be presented. They are as follows:

Article IV 2-2 No. 20 Multiple Housing Units.

Section 5-3 G Business Districts, residences maintained in conjunction with a business.

Section 7 7: 1-B Each parcel of land must have the specified width frontage for its district, lying adjacent to a legally constituted public street or road; or adjacent to an approved private road as designated by agreement with the Novesta Township Board.
