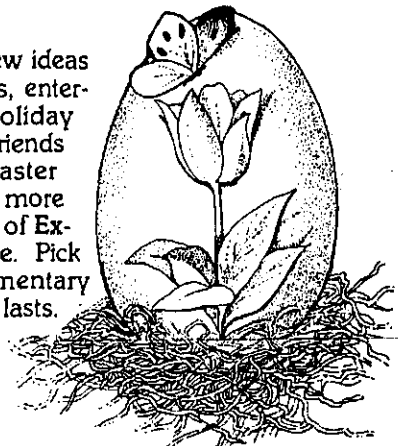

Grain task force hearing Monday

State Rep. Quincy Hoffman (R-Applegate), a member of the House Republican Grain Task Force, has announced the panel will be at Bad Axe Monday to gather input from farmers and agribusiness leaders on the current state of the grain industry in Michigan.

The public hearing, one of four scheduled around the state, will be on the third floor of the Huron County Building at 1 p.m.

"I encourage all interested citizens to attend the hearing," Hoffman said. "The hearings will allow us to take some local input back to Lansing in our attempts to help grain farmers through these tough times."

He said the six-member task force appointed at the beginning of February, has already been addressed by several state agriculture officials concerning the storage and shipment by rail, truck and ship of the state's grain, and research being done at Michigan State University on alcohol fuels.
