Aid available for crippled children


Caring for a handicapped child can be a burden greater than many parents' financial and insurance resources can bear.

The crippled children program at the Tuscola County Health Department can help parents with financial planning, help them get in touch with the proper specialist, and in many cases, assume all or part of the health-care costs.

Dr. Kalyani Misra, medical director for the Health Department, explained, "The main goals of the Crippled Children Program are to locate any children under the age of 21 who are crippled or may have a condition leading to crippling, and to see that each child receives the health care they need."

Persons who believe their child may have a crippling condition can contact the crippled children representatives at the Health Department, who will assist in determining medical and financial eligibility for the program. Call 673-8114 between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
