

Deadline nears for license tabs

The end of an old tradition in Michigan is fast approaching. Monday, March 31, will be the last day to buy new license plate tabs. They must be mounted on plates by the following day. Starting with 1981 license plates, they will expire on the car owner's birthday, thus eliminating the last minute long lines at secretary of state's offices. The Caro office, located in the village hall on State Street, will be retaining its

regular hours, 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Tuesdays and 9 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Fridays. Tabs can also be purchased at the AAA office in Caro on Millwood Street, behind the state police post. The secretary of state offices in Bad Axe and Sandusky are open from 9 a.m.-5:30 p.m. weekdays and Saturday, March 29, will be open from 8:30 a.m.-1 p.m. The Bad Axe office is at 47 Westland Drive, in the small shopping center off M-53 on the west side of town. The Sandusky office is at 93 S. Elk Street. Last minute lines this year may be longer than usual. As of March 14, according to Secretary of State Richard Austin, only 3.8 million registrations had been sold, compared with 4.3 million as of the same time last year.

Kindergarten registration next month

Campbell Elementary School pre-kindergarten registration and visitation will take place Tuesday and Wednesday evening, April 15-16.

Rural parents and their child to be enrolled are asked to come April 15 at 6:30 p.m. Town parents and their child are to come the following day at the same time. At all schools, there will be a 1 1/2-hour schedule of activities, with children visiting their kindergarten rooms. Evergreen elementary parents and their child will register at that school April 15, starting at 2 p.m. At Deford Elementary, parents and children should be there at 1 p.m., April 16. Parents are to bring birth certificates and immunization records for their child to the meetings. Children must be 5 years old prior to Dec. 1, 1980, to be eligible for enrollment. The state requires a pre-school vision test. A free vision and hearing clinic day for all pre-schoolers will be conducted at each school to meet the requirement. Deford children will be screened May 12 and Campbell Elementary children, May 12 and 14. The date for Evergreen Elementary will be announced later. Parents who do not bring their children on the clinic days will have to make appointments with their own doctors.
