First, an outdated product has usually undergone a chemical or physical change. This new chemical can be harmful.

Secondly, in the process of change the new chemical does not act in the same way that the original medication did and may not help you to become well. This can be life-threatening as in the case of nitroglycerine.

Nitroglycerine is very bitter and very easily destroyed by moisture, light and heat. Every month or two test your nitroglycerine by placing a tablet under your tongue. Do this even if the expiration date has not been reached. If it is not bitter throw it away and get a new prescription or refill. Even if you do not have small children in your home regularly, it is important for you to reduce the potential for accidental poisoning. Remember that the vast majority of the medications and potential poisons DO NOT

have an antidote. There are only a few antidotes available for a few poisons. If your medicine chest is cluttered, it is very easy to grab the wrong bottle or an outdated medi-


