Lutheran women plan spring rally

Plans for the annual Spring Rally and the two-day retreat are being finalized for April by the Thumb zone of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League.

"No, thank you, I'm not interested" is the topic chosen by Rev. Steven Biegel, who will be the guest speaker for the Tuesday, April 15, evening rally at St. John's Lutheran church, Port Hope. Approximately 100 women from Lutheran congregations throughout the Thumb are expected to attend the gathering, which begins with registration and dessert at 6:30 p.m.

Rev. Biegel is pastor of Grace Lutheran church of Fairgrove which he has served since his graduation from Concordia Theological Seminary, Springfield, Ill., in 1976. He is the author of an evangelism manual, Speaking of Salvation, and is area director of Ongoing Ambassadors for Christ, a high school witnessing training program.

Opening devotions by the Rev. Lavern Nutzmann and a short business meeting will be included in the evening's program. The offering will be given to the Lutheran Hour Rally Followup Bible Study Program or to the Michigan District Project Fund.

For the April 23-24 retreat at Lake Huron Methodist Camp, near Jeddo, Cass City-Anns will be the keynote speaker. Presently pastor of St. Peter's Lutheran church, Minneapolis, Minn., he formerly served St. John's congregation in Port Hope. He has chosen "Untapped Power" as his topic.

Included in the program, which begins with a 5:30 supper Wednesday, will be Bible Study, group discussions, recreation, singing and fellowship. An informal communion service will close retreat Thursday evening after supper.
