

Gas tax increase is unnecessary

The effects of smaller cars and motorists driving less are being felt.

If, however, the result will be an increase in the gasoline tax, Christine Joles is opposed. The price of gasoline, she said, "is high enough now.'

Except for a small percentage for public transportation and railroads, revenue from the state gasoline tax (11 cents per gallon), diesel fuel tax and license plate fees are all spent for road construction maintenance.

While those costs are going up 10-20 percent a year, the Michigan Department of Transportation reported last week, fuel tax and license plate fee revenue declined 4.5 percent for the first three months of this year, compared to the same period last year.

The situation has led to a call by highway interests for an eventual increase in the fuel tax, perhaps by setting it as a percentage of the price per gallon instead of the present flat rate. That way, highway revenue will increase as the price of gasoline increases.
