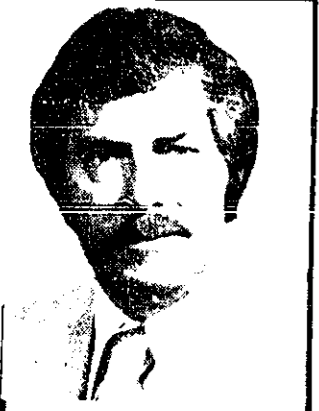
## Cass Cityan to visit Sweden

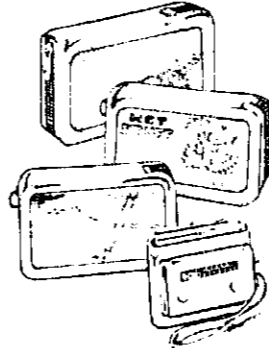

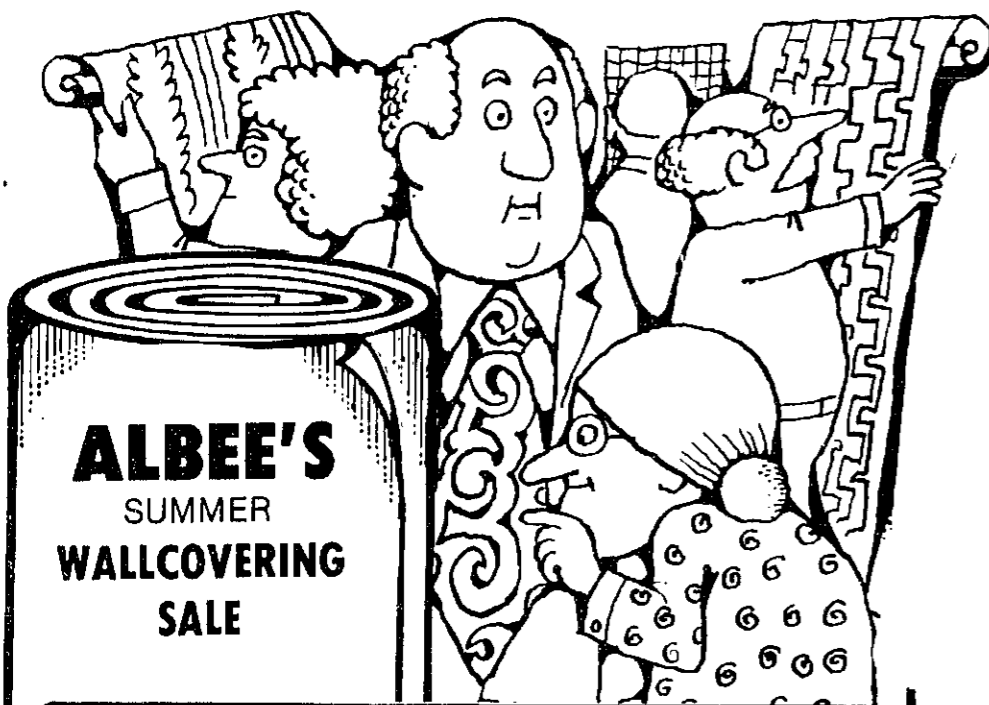
