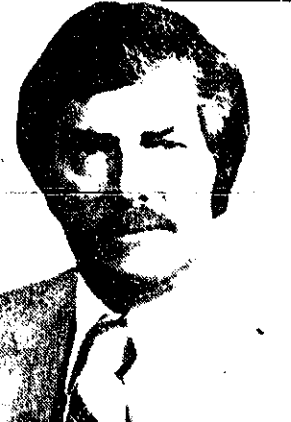


Judging starts Friday

The Navy provided water transportation through the Venice canals for the President, his family, cabinet officers and other staff members.

He was specially chosen to serve with the boat group by his parent command, and was sent to Venice for the three-week effort.
