Aug. 11, the following questions will be discussed:

- 1) Do you think that most older people understand the extent of coverage that exists in private insurance policies and the government sponsored programs of Medicare and Medicaid?
- 2) Do you think that the health insurance options available to older people (Medicare, private insurance, and Medicaid) adequately cover their health care costs?
- 3) Do we need a national health insurance plan which would simplify insurance reimbursement and guarantee basic health care for all people?
- 4) Have you been able to find adequate health care in this area, or have you been forced to go to the larger cities to find it?
- 5) Has the amount of health care available to you in the Thumb increased over the last 10 years?
- 6) What types of health facilities are either totally missing or in inadequate numbers in the Thumb area?
- 7) Should preventive care be a major objective of our health care system?
- 8) Do you think it is more important to attempt to increase services in the home to help with such tasks as minor home maintenance and repair or to increase housing complexes for the elderly such as the one in Caro?
- 9) Do you think apartment housing complexes should be developed for the elderly which would also offer some basic services such as a noontime meal, light house-keeping assistance, etc.?
- 10) What are the three most important services which would help older persons maintain their independence in their own homes?

Demolition of the McNeil property has yet to begin. The county has put a lien on the property and is seeking payment before demolition is to begin.

Village President, Lambert Althaver, received a phone call from James R. Suchodolski, vice-president, Eastern Operations for Wickes' Agriculture, concerning their property at Garfield Street.
