cal centers, undertook the enormous task of determining whether all known strains of polio virus (more than 100) belonged to one or another of the three types. During the next three years, wholly supported by the March of Dimes, he identified within each type a single strain which evoked maximum response in test animals. The result was a three-way (trivalent) vaccine, composed of killed virus particles from each of

the three chosen strains. Next came the most massive field test in history, begun in 1953. Involved were 1.8 million children in 44 states, as well as health professionals and the lay public.

Results of the field trials showed that Dr. Salk had truly developed a safe, effective weapon against polio. The vaccine was put into wide use and by 1961 reported polio cases in the United States had dropped 96 percent below the prevaccine average.

Meanwhile, Dr. Albert Sabin, another long-time researcher in the field of polio. continued his work on an oral vaccine as the next step in the fight against polio. The March of Dimes totally supported Sabin in his research.

In 1962, the oral vaccine was fully licensed and is now the major preventative means used in this country, although a number of other






