SOYBEAN TOUR SET IN SANILAC

The Sanilac County Cooperative Extension Service announces there will be a county soybean tour Wednesday, Sept. 3, in the Crosswell area in the morning and Marlette area in the afternoon.

There are 41 different varieties of soybeans that were planted in two different locations in the county. The tour group will see them, plus narrow row soybeans planted with a "lye" drill. They will also see the MSU overstate soybean varieties which were also planted in narrow rows.

The morning tour will start at 10 at the Wilson Brothers' Farm at 2665 Wellman Line Road, two miles east of Roseburg and one mile south. From there the group will go to the Harold Furness Farm, one mile north of Galbraith Line Road at 7716 Kilgore Road.

The afternoon tour will start at 1:30 at the overstate soybean trials on the Tom Taylor Farm, two miles east of Marlette on Howard Road and a quarter-mile south.

The group will then move to the Goodwine Brothers' Farm on Walker Road right at the Cass River.

Michigan State University personnel will be present to discuss the varieties, narrow row vs. conventional, insects and disease control, weed control and fertilization.
