EMT class starts soon at hospital

Registrations are now being accepted for an emergency medical technical class to be held at Hills and Dales General Hospital, Cass City, starting Monday, Sept. 22.

The course will include 128 class hours with an additional 10 hours in the clinical area. The class is coordinated through Mid-Michigan Community College and is approved by Michigan Department of Public Health.

Those who successfully complete the class will receive 6 hours credit from Mid-Michigan and be eligible to apply for testing by the Michigan Department of Public Health to become a licensed EMT. EMTs usually work as ambulance attendants.

The course fee will include tuition, texts and name tags, and is payable the first night of class.

A decision will be made the first night of class. Mrs. Hubbard said, on what night will be the best for all students to meet. The class will usually meet one night a week.
