## New books at the library

ATHABASCA, by Alistair MacLean (fiction). With an American as the central figure, an exotic locale (the oil-rich tar sands of Athabasca along Alaska's Arctic shore), a fast-moving story, where an entire oil-producing industry is held hostage, the usual MacLean touches - amazing twists of plot, almost unbearable suspense, an ending as explosive as any he has yet concocted - "Athabasca" promises to be another MacLean winner.

PROMISES, by Charlotte Vale Allen (fiction). In a novel that perhaps only women will totally understand, Charlotte Vale Allen tells the powerfully emotional story of two beautiful sisters. Orphaned and penniless, Jess Greaves pledges to take care of her younger sister, Tillie. Though it fills her with shame and guilt, Jess becomes a prostitute to put Tillie through school. But Tillie, totally self-absorbed and spoiled, refuses to recognize her sister's sacrifice and repays her with a frenzy of hatred, greed and jealousy. After years of separations, loves, marriages and personal tragedies, they meet again. And they have one last chance to either understand and love each other or forever be separated.

DRESSING THIN, by Dale Goday (non-fiction). Goday asserts that the right clothing can make anyone look significantly thinner and offers specific pointers to help readers achieve desired "thin lines." She warns against common "camouflaging" tactics - wearing baggy clothing or trying to fit into too-tight clothes for the sake of buying a smaller size. This little book contains a good number of valuable hints.

## AAUW meeting

The Cass City branch of the American Association of University Women held a new season with a meeting last Wednesday evening in

the high school library. President Barbara Tuckey introduced the speaker, Rod Smith, professor of biology at Delta College. His talk and discussion concerned energy management and problems. This introduced one of the association's topics for the year, "Managing Tomorrow's Resources."

Smith came to Delta from Ohio State University where he spent eight years working and studying in this field. He will soon complete a textbook on ecology. "Families Facing Change" is the second topic for special programs and discussion during the coming year for AAUW.

## Sprouted wheat seed still useable

Growers and seed processors are urged to treat all wheat seed being planted this fall even if it is sprouted.

Larry Copeland, Michigan State University Cooperative Extension Service agronomist, says that as much as half of the crop or more of the soft white wheat in Michigan this summer may have some degree of sprouting.

In spite of sprouting, the seed can be planted and still develop into a good yielding plant.

Germination tests by MSU Agricultural Experiment Station researchers show that sprouted wheat seed should be treated the same as any ordinary wheat. Their research indicates treating does not damage the seed.

There has been some concern that sprouted wheat seed lots continue to deteriorate. This is probably due to insufficient drying. Any wheat seed, sprouted or not, will deteriorate if the moisture content is 14 percent or greater.

Growers are reminded that regardless of how wheat seed has been handled or stored, a germination test by a reputable seed laboratory should be performed to determine its planting quality.
