The Penn Central Corp. and GK Technologies, Inc. have announced a modified agreement for the acquisition of GK Technologies, parent company of General Cable, by Penn Central. The agreement provides that Penn Central will make a cash tender offer for any and all shares of common stock of GK for \$47 per share and for any and all shares of convertible preference stock for \$55.93 per share. The proposed transactions are subject to approval by the board of directors of Penn Central, and approval and recommendation of acceptance to GK Technologies' shareholders by its board of directors. The transactions are also subject to the arrangement by Penn Central of firm commitments for financing these transactions, and the execution of definitive agreements. The proposed transactions replace Penn Central's original proposal announced July 7, which would have afforded holders of GK common and convertible preference shares the choice of \$45 per share and \$53.55 per share in cash, respectively, or a tax-free exchange of GK shares for a new series of Penn Central \$5.27 special preference stock.

## HEALTH TIPS Rh disease findings save many babies

Rh disease, a serious disorder of the newborn, was first described in the writings of Hippocrates thousands of years ago. Yet it was not until 1968 that an acceptable preventive was approved that permits many parents with Rh incompatibility to have more than one child without fear. The Rh factor is a protein substance on the surface of the red blood cells of 85 percent of the population. Such people are said to be Rh positive. The 15 percent who do not have this factor are called Rh negative. Each year in the United States, says a pamphlet from the American Medical Association, at least 200,000 women with Rh negative blood marry men whose blood is Rh positive. The first child causes little or no problem. But each subsequent pregnancy carries a risk that the child will be born anemic or even stillborn. One treatment has been an exchange blood transfusion. Most of the newborn's blood is replaced immediately after birth with fresh, safe blood. This helps the infant survive. In recent years physicians learned how to carry out this blood exchange transfusion while the child is still within the mother. These methods saved many, but not enough, of the thousands of babies affected by Rh disease. In 1968 a new preventive treatment — anti-Rh immune globulin — was approved. Administered to Rh negative mothers within three days after delivery of each Rh positive baby, or each Rh positive abortion, it blocks development in the mother of sensitization against the baby's Rh positive red blood cells. Use of this anti-Rh immune globulin for mothers has been so near 100 percent effective that parents who
