





No doubt the food served by townspeople is one reason the musicians are returning.

Among those coming back is Jaeger as conductor and music director. The latter title means he is responsible for lining up the musicians who will perform and selecting the program.

He has been conductor of the Midland Symphony for 12 years and also conducts the Northwestern Michigan Symphony and Northwood Symphonette, which in March of next year will perform its first annual 'Festival of the Desert" in Palm Springs, Calif., followed by its debut at Lincoln Center in New York City. He has been guest conductor of numerous symphonies in this country and Europe.

Starting one hour before the start of each concert, Byron Hanson will present a lecture about Bach and the Baroque period in which he lived. Hanson is resident conductor of the Interlochen Arts Academy Orchestra.

Joining him for the Friday evening lecture will be Dana Hull, who restored the more than 100-year-old Henry Erban built tracker organ at the church.

The "Spirit of the Baroque" slide-tape presentation and exhibit at Rawson Memorial Library continues through Dec. 5. Hours are 1-3 p.m. Monday, Tuesday. Thursday, Friday and Saturday; 7-9 p.m. Mondays and Fridays, and this Sunday only, noon-2:30 p.m.
