the only way to find that out is to figure the premium with both companies.

Friday, he was still waiting for the new premiums from the companies his agency represents, but the estimate presented at seminars he "had attended was that rates for all but the single young male drivers would go up an average of 10-15 percent.

THE LAW NARROWS the grounds for which persons can be refused insur-

For auto insurance, it permits refusal because of license suspension or revocation, insurance fraud, cancellation for non-payment of premium in the previous two years and for accumulated "insurance eligibility points," a new point system for traffic accidents and violations.

Each time a driver is in an accident or gets a ticket, he will accumulate points, which will boost the premium. Beyond a certain point, however, the car own- er policy premiums will go er will have to buy insurance up 10-15 percent. through the "high risk pool," for which they pay a Music program higher premium.

Because a person's driving record plays a bigger factor in the premiums, "It's a more equitable rating," Harris said. "If there is a good thing about the new law, that's it."

On the other hand, Harris explained, a person may have a good driving record for many years, only to have a couple accidents or tickets within a couple of years. Under the old system, he might have been able to stay with his insurer, but under the new system, it will be automatically into the pool.

THE ASSIGNED RISK pool, saccording to Edward H. Doerr of Doerr Insurance Agency, has always been a money losing proposition for the insurance companies. which means it has to be subsidized through higher

rates are set so low the loss will be even greater, until maybe 6 months to a year from now, when losses will be known so rates can be adjusted accordingly.

Doerr also predicts big losses from the homeowners insurance pool for homes in high risk areas, such as the inner city in Detroit. He expects it-will-be-an incentive for arsonists to burn homes to collect the insurance money.

Of the two companies he represents for homeowners insurance, one hasn't raised its rates yet and the other lowered them by increasing the deductible amount the claimant must pay before he can receive reimbursement for his loss. He figures the companies

are waiting until they can gauge the amount of claims under the new system before increasing premiums but expects eventually they will go up "a heck of a lot more." Harris expects homeown-




