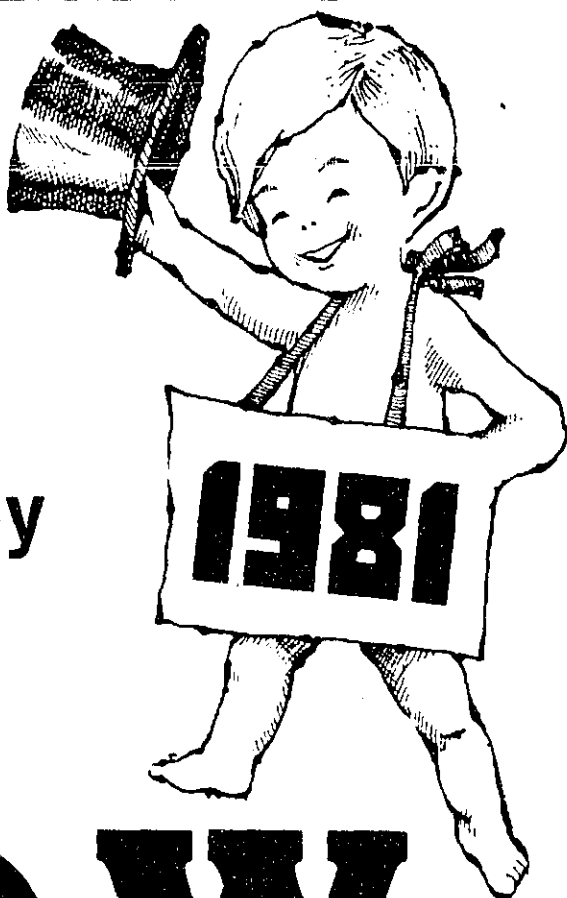

The 12-week course was conducted at the Naval Construction Training Center, Gulfport, Miss. It was designed to provide students with basic technical skills in construction, earthmoving and roadbuilding operations.

Students received instruction on the operation, adjustment and servicing of hauling, loading, lifting and ditching equipment - soil compactors, crawler tractors and wheeled, tractor-drawn scrapers. Additionally, they studied the fundamentals of earthwork and combustion engines, including related fuels and lubricants.

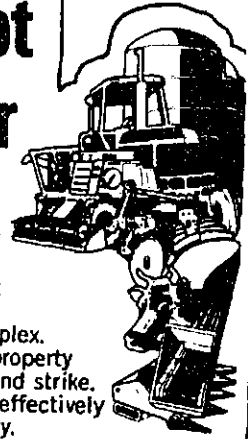

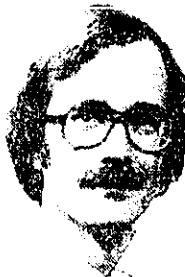
