Of Votes Cast at the Spring Election Held on the 1st Day of April, 1901.

STATEMENT OF VOTES given in the county of Tuscola state of Michigan, for the following state officers, viz: Justice of the Supreme Court and regents of the university, also for County Commissioner of Schools and the amendment to the constitution relative to Circuit Court affecting Bay County; amendment to constitution relative to compensation of members of the legislature and also on question relative to the prohibition of the liquor traffic within the county.

Statement of votes given in the County of Tuscola, State of Michigan, for the following State Officers, viz: Justice of the Supreme Court and two Regents of the University, and for the following County Officer, viz: County Commissioner of Schools, at the General Election held in said County on Monday the first day of April, in the year one thousand nine hundred and one.

The whole number of votes given for the office of Justice of the Supreme Court was 6,563 and they were given for the following persons, viz: Robert M. Montgomery received 3,977 votes; Walter S. Westerman received 829 votes; Shepard Cowles received 48 votes; James E. McBride received 57 votes; George A. Eastman received 234 votes; Allen C. Adsit received 1,332 votes. Total 6,568.

The whole number of votes given for the office of regents of the University was 13,038 and they were given for the following persons, viz: Frank W. Fletcher received 3,930; Archibald Butters received 818 votes; Willis F. King received 48 votes; Perry R. Crosby received 155 votes; Edward W. H. Smith received 242 votes; Elmer R. Goldsmith received 1,325 votes; Henry W. Carey received 3,929 votes; Joshua Stansfield received 819 votes; Barney Fabinski received 52 votes; Oscar Shermehorn received 155 votes; Daniel J. Jeanneret received 241 votes; Edmond C. Shields received 1,324 votes. Total 13,038.

The whole number of votes given for the office of County Commissioner of Schools was 4,924 and they were given for the following persons, viz: Henry P. Bush received 4,020; Howard Luther received 898 votes. Total 4,924.
