FREE TO CHOOSE: A PERSONAL STATEMENT, by Milton and Rose D. Friedman (non-fiction). Nobel Prizewinning economist Friedman and his wife present a popularized defense of free-market capitalism. Friedman believes that political freedom cannot exist without economic freedom; government interference with market forces will necessarily produce political and financial tyranny, as well-chosen examples from past and present U.S. history demonstrate. While the Friedmans decry the expansion and consolidation of government power and influence, they acknowledge that an absolutely laissez-faire system will produce some economic problems. CATO'S WAR, by Guy Wheeler (fiction). In a compelling historical novel, Wheeler clears away the romantic myths of the American Revolution. The war is seen through the astute eyes of Philip Cato, a capable British colonel working on special assignment under his friend General Cornwallis. A loyal soldier, Cato takes the American assignment despite his own doubts about the wisdom or justice of the war; so the anguish of the revolution is relayed through a man who finds himself in love with one cousin, Lucy, and in combat against other relatives, social worker. including George Washington.

AUTHORITY, by Richard Sennett (non-fiction). The founder of the New York Institute of the Humanities at New York University presents the first of four planned books "on the emotional bonds of modern society." With sensitivity and sharp reasoning, Sennett looks at the nature of the exertion of authority, why it is necessary, why people in this day and age are afraid of it, and how the exercise of it can be readjusted along more humanistic lines to lessen this fear. His perspective is broad - from the family to the nation-state level, with major emphasis on the workplace.

The hunt is for the western and northern corn rootworm beetles which have a very similar biology and are equally destructive if not

antennae. ting the the field (beyond the headlands and margins) taking counts on 60 corn

plants at both ends and the middle of the field. numerous on the silks, tassels, and bases of leaves and ears. Count only the numbers of adults you can

easily see on the plants without stripping back the leaves or husks. If there are more than 172 adult beetles per 180 plants,

and the field is to be planted to corn next year, an insecticide will probably have to be used at planting or just after plant emergence next year. An alternative to using insecticide next year is to rotate the corn with another

Dudek also advises that where corn will replace small grains or alfalfa, growers should make a similar survey for the adult beetle. The adults feed only including soybeans, dry edible beans, and alfalfa.
